### **Brighton Volunteer Ambulance clears adjoining property for future expansion**

Heavy equipment has been busy clearing the property at 1575 Winton Rd., next door to the Brighton Volunteer Ambulance base. BVA purchased the home from the Gonsenhauser family in 2005. For now, the property will be developed to provide additional parking for BVA staff and visitors.

Long range plans for Brighton Volunteer Ambulance include an expanded base to help fulfill its mission of providing 24 hour advanced and basic life support to the town of Brighton and surrounding communities. BVA has grown its staff of career and volunteer EMTs and Paramedics, and its fleet of ambulances, to meet increasing demand for services. In 2008 BVA responded to over 4600 calls for emergency care.

A larger base will make it possible to continue the high level of care that BVA provides for Brighton residents. Additionally, more space will make it possible for BVA to offer CPR and other training to Brighton residents.
